TOWN CLERK The Town Clerk requested a temporary leave from the Committee for the present time as she is taking on extra duties due to the leave of the CAO.

SHOAL HARBOUR CAUSEWAY SIGNS Discussion took place regarding the interpretation/location signs for placement by the steps at the causeway. Chairperson Tilley and Promotional Coordinator will compile a set of specs for the signage. RECOMMENDATION: That quotes be obtained for 7 aluminum frames/holders for the signs. As well a written copy of specs will be faxed to the 2 local sign companies for quotes.

APPLICATION - KATIMAVIK STUDENTS It was decided that the Beautification Committee would not be applying for Katimavik Students this year because there would be no supervision available.

SHORELINE MARKET Discussion took place for the operation of the Shoreline Market. It was decided that we need to look into having a person supervising the market for the openings on Saturdays. It will continue to open from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturdays. The committee will look into having an electrical drop brought to the site. Other items brought to the Committee's attention was the need for a boardwalk to the beach; that kiosks be used only for product sales; the need for an open building with a roof for tables for yard sale items.

PERENNIAL EXCHANGE It was decided that a Perennial Exchange would be held at the Shoreline Market around the end of September. This will be advertised in the Fall Newsletter.

TOURIST INFO It was brought to the Committee's attention that there is a need for Tourist Information. RECOMMENDATION: That the Promotional Coordinator put together a kit for tourists with a schedule outlining the events which are taking place in our Town, as well as the attractions. These kits would be placed at the Tourist Chalet, Malls, Churches, etc.
