BUDGET A brief discussion took place regarding the budget for 2007, while reviewing the expenses to date.

HANGING FLOWER BASKETS After a brief discussion it was decided that because of the high winds in the area, the hanging flower baskets will not be placed along the causeway. They will be placed along the walkway from the steps to Balbo Drive near the wharf.

SUMMER STUDENTS Town Clerk reported that 4 students have been hired to commence work July 3rd. in addition to the 2 Katimavik students. 2 more have been approved and she is waiting to hear from the SWASP program.

SHORELINE MARKET Discussion took place as to what could be added to the Shoreline Market this year. It was decided that sods, soil, 2 picnic tables and 2 benches would be purchased, as well as ballards and rope. It was also decided that the site should have an electrical drop with pole in order to provide electricity to the site. Dept. of Public Works will be notified re the placment of the directional signs for the market

CLARENVILLE DAY Suggestions for activities for Clarenville Day were discussed. A couple of ideas were a picnic similar to a Sunday School Picnic, Duck Race and a G.P.S Challenge.

FLEA MARKET A suggestion was made to have a giant flea market at the Shoreline Market in order to get people to the area, while endeavouring to promote the market.

GARDENING CONTEST Cr. Müller will get a couple of slates painted for the gardening contest and Chairperson Tilley will line up the judges.

LIGHTING OF THE FALLS Proposal received from Tract Consulting Inc. for professional services for the Interpretation & Site Design of the Lower Shoal Harbour River. Committee is awaiting the proposal from Artifact Design Studio. The committee also discussed developing the whole area as opposed to just lighting the falls.

TOWN SIGNAGE Discussion took place re developing a policy re town signs, with respect as to what they should have on them, i.e. logo, font size, white space, reading level, etc. It was decided that a copy of what we already have will be printed and discussed at a future meeting.

GARBAGE/RECYCLE BINS The committee inspected the new garbage and recycle containers which recently arrived. It was decided that the containers would be bolted to a pole and the cover would be attached to the container with a chain. CARA employees will place them in the designated areas.

CROWN LAND MANITOBA DRIVE It has been determined that the vacant land in front of Clarenville Medical Arts and the Wirco properties on Manitoba Drive is crown land and there would be no problem with the Town cleaning it up.
