CAUSEWAY SIGNS

Discussion took place re the signs for the steps/causeway area. A suggestion had been made to split the info for the environment and ecology signs and have one extra sign made to accommodate this. This was agreed upon by the committee. Tenders were received as follows:

SHORELINE PARK &
MARKET

<u>NON-CONFORMING SIGNS</u>	Discussion took place re non-conforming signs posted on trees and poles around Town. It was decided to ask the Public Works Department to start implementation of removing non-conforming signs.
<u>NEWSLETTER</u>	It was decided that a fall newsletter would be published between September 30 th - October 15 th .
<u>WELLNESS TRAIL</u>	Discussion took place re the triangle of land at the intersection of Gladney Street/Hibernia Drive area and the dangers the area could impose. It was decided that Recreation Director would have his employees thin out the vegetation in the area which in turn would make it more visible.
<u>ENFORCEMENT OFFICER</u>	Enforcement Officer joined the meeting.
<u>GARDEN COMPETITION</u>	Pictures of the flower gardens were judged by the committee. 3 entries were received and the winner was 11 Strong's Road.
