SHOAL HARBOUR  
CAUSEWAY SIGNS

Promotional Coordinator had a sample of material that will be used for the signs for the steps/causeway area. It was noted that extra protection be used on the front of the signs and the signs be placed on plywood for extra durability. As well the signs be trimmed with black. Quotes for mounting of the signs will be available for next meeting. It was noted that the Beautification and Enhancement Committees had met on September 19<sup>th</sup> and the sods are in place. The erosion of the embankment was also discussed.

RECOMMENDATION: To proceed to order the six signs as per above and four trial marker signs with headers and trimmed with black be ordered as well. The erosion of the embankment be referred to the Public Works Department.
